Paper tinted in faint gold and silver; black and white sumi-e brushwork in the lower portion depicting a building on a bridge, rooftops, trees in a courtyard, and bullock carts and drivers. Upper portion is undecorated. Metal door pull on the right. Framed in black lacquer.
